Dear **George**:

I hope this message finds you well.

I am writing to follow~up on my application for admission to the **Supreme Court Bar** and to let you know that I am moving forward in faith that I will gain the sponsorship I need and be admitted in time to file a crucial *amicus* brief on or before **October 9, 2025**, opposing certiorari, and informing the Court of **fraud**, in the matter *Alex Emric Jones, et al., Petitioners v. Erica Lafferty, et al.*, **Case No. 25-268**. For your reference (and possible sharing with another potential sponsor), I am attaching copies of the following:

As the collection of attachments indicate, I've sent the *amicus* brief to the printer, and I will be ready to file by the middle part of next week, save the essential requirement of gaining admission to the **Supreme Court Bar**.

As is required by **Supreme Court Rule 37.2**, Footnote 1 of my *amicus* brief states (in anticipation) that I (will) have sent counsel for the parties email notice, on September 29, 2025, of my intent to file said *amicus* brief in opposition to *certiorari* and in support of no party. As is required by **Supreme Court Rule 37.6**, Footnote 1 of my *amicus* brief also provides the following disclosures:

The undersigned *Pro Se Attorney Amicus Curiae*, Robert Wyn Young, established a GiveSendGo campaign in January 2025 (givesengo.com/wyn-young) to help fund the undersigned's public advocacy case described herein. To date, said GiveSendGo campaign has raised \$2,701.00 via 36 donations. The Trust by Beau Jangles, West Columbia, TX, Trustee "Kelly" (last name unknown), made a separate \$2,500.00 cash donation/contribution in September 2025 designated to cover costs and expenses associated with the preparation and submission of this *amicus* brief.

As my **GiveSendGo campaign** description indicates, I quit my day job back in January to meet the demands of and to further pursue this public advocacy case. I am duty~bound to

support and defend the Constitution, even at great personal cost. I've lost my home for suppression of and consequent lack of funding to my public advocacy case. To keep going, I even had to sell my guitar, which I considered my most prized material possession, and which I used to play **lullabies for my daughter** when I was raising her (and to the present day).

I am willing to do what it takes to get this essential *amicus* brief filed. As I've said many times, "This case is much bigger than me." As stated at Pages 23~24 of the brief, the following is at stake:

The practical goals of the parties' collusion may and should be assessed in light of the practical effects foreseeably generated thereby: (1) a false public impression that *Sullivan, supra*, has been reversed and that public figure defamation plaintiffs no longer need to prove actual malice to recover; (2) a massive chilling of freedom of speech and of the press, especially with respect to controversial issues, and for fear of massive defamation liability; (3) a corruption of the integrity of the federal judicial system, which the colluding parties have misused and abused, on multiple levels, in order to perpetrate their **treasonous fraud**; and (4) an overall undermining of the First and Second Amendments, the core and foundational rights of the American Republic.

If it will take coming to Washington for an open~court admission session, I am willing to do so. The print job for the *amicus* brief cost less than half of what I anticipated and, therefore, I should have enough to travel to D.C. on a budget and if necessary. My daughter, who just started at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, this fall and who is interested in a future career in the law, is both willing (and excited) to cut classes and accompany me to Washington for an admission ceremony and the filing ~ if that's what's in the cards.
